TEEN PAGE tier one tasks

Shelving:

Learn how the different sections of the stacks are organized and insert books/media correctly.

Update New Book Shelf:

Remove the oldest month of new books and work in the newest month of books.

Shelf Reading:

Ensure the correct placement of books/media on the shelves. Choose display items as needed.

Shifting:

Learn how to shift books/media across shelves for the best fit of the resources present.

Organization:

Keep the craft closet and games cupboard organized. Check for missing pieces, replace missing signage, select a game of the week to be displayed above the cupboard.

TEEN ASSISTANT tier two tasks

Maker:

Build Take and Make craft kits for teens and tweens or assist with projects as needed around the Teen Space or Children's room.

Mindfulness Media:

Find and print coloring pages or activity sheets for the teen space tables.

Video Game Oversight:

Shelf reading the game organization in the glass floor room.

Shelf Reading:

Ensure the correct placement of books/media on the shelves. Choose display items as needed.

On Search Management:

Look for books or media that have an On Search. Weeding outdated materials from lists provided by the librarian.

TEEN INFLUENCER tier three tasks

Book Reviews Organizer:

Maintain/develop and explore the organization and use of the book and media review forms.

Visualizer:

Create book/media displays, read alike/play alike lists, book/media list bookmarks and info flyers.

Reading Troubador:

Share your love of books by reading to our younger patrons in the Kid's room.

Event Support:

Assisting with setup, activities during, and break down of youth services events.

Organization:

Keep the craft closet and games cupboard organized. Check for missing pieces, replace missing signage, select a game of the week to be displayed above the cupboard.

TEEN ADVISORY BOARD tier four tasks

Book Advisory:

Be familiar with the books the library owns, use on search lists to determine which books need to be replaced. Research and create lists of books to purchase with a set amount of funding.

Tech Advisory:

Be familiar with the games the library owns, use on search lists to determine which games need to be replaced. Research and create lists of games to purchase with a set amount of funding.

Program Advisory:

Be familiar with the types of programming the Teen Space has held in the recent past and suggest new programs or events that would be popular with students in the local schools. Work within a budget.

Website Advisory:

Review Teens Landing page and other resources accessible through the website and make suggestions for additional resources or removal of resources.
